

## Troop 2018 Summer Camp Personal Gear List

Check this list twice to make sure you have everything. All items should have the scout's name labeled on them.

Item	Check off:
Foot locker, suitcase, backpack or large duffle bag (or more than 1) for your stuff	
Reusable water bottle	
Sleeping bag, and maybe a sheet for hot nights	
Small pillow or a pillowcase you can stuff clothes in to make a pillow	
Day pack (with swimsuit, sunblock, towel for check-in swim quals if not already done)	
Camping stool or chair	
Flashlight with extra batteries	
Pocket knife or multi-tool	
Personal first aid kit	
Medicine in its original container (give to adult dispensing medicine for the week)	
Some sort of bag for your dirty clothes	
Activity uniforms (T's) for the week. Should have green (or khaki) bottoms if possible. Wear Field Uniform to/from camp and to dinner, campfire, ceremonies. No tank tops or crop tops. Don't forget your co-ed environment appropriate PJ's! EXTRA undies and socks so they can be changed out regularly on really hot days or if we get a lot of rain. Check to see if your merit badge classes require special clothing.	
Sweatshirt, jacket, or troop fleece for cool nights	
Rain gear	
Sun hat or bandana, and sunglasses	
Swim suit: Tankini, swim shorts & shirt, or one-piece. Goggles are optional.	
2 towels, washcloth, shower shoes/flip-flops/crocs (for pool deck or in-shower use only, shampoo/conditioner, and soap (body wash or soap in a box)	
Closed-toed water shoes or old sneakers if you are going to be on the waterfront for boating	
Hiking boots (waterproof for wet days if possible) or old sneakers. Maybe a second pair in case the first pair gets wet.	
Bug repellent (non-aerosol)	
Sunscreen (non-aerosol)	
Toothbrush and toothpaste	
Deodorant, hairbrush, sanitary supplies, and any other necessary toiletries, or orthodontic/vision supplies	
Scout handbook and (if earned) Totin' Chip and Firem'n Chit	
Notebook/notepad & pen/pencil AND a self-stamped, home-addressed envelope/paper	
Watch or other time device	
Spending money for snacks, stuff you need, or fun stuff at the trading post. \$20-40	
Merit badge prerequisite materials/work	
OA sash if you are in the Order of the Arrow	
Optional items: bug netting, battery fan, compass, camera, frisbees, sports equipment, religious or other reading material, cards, games, musical instruments, stuff for skits, lantern, sleeping pad for your cot. Cell phones may be brought, but they must be handed to Ms. Catherine at check-in to only be used for short calls home at night.	

**DO NOT BRING:** Food/snacks, candy, soda, electronics, matches, fireworks, sheath knives, or hatchets.
